The Netzarim & Orthodox Rabbis have prophesied about the conditions just before the Messiah comes.

“He will not arrive on the Sabbath, since that would require people to violate the Sabbath in welcoming him [Babylonian Talmud Pesahim 13a]. [The prophet] Elijah [who is supposed to usher in the messianic age] will arrive no later in the week than Thursday, leaving room for the Messiah to arrive by Friday. Elijah will announce the arrival of the Messiah from Mount Carmel in the Land of Israel [Jerusalem Talmud Pesahim 3:6].”

"In the footsteps of the Messiah, arrogance [chutzpah] will increase; prices will rise; grapes will be abundant but wine will be costly; the government will turn into heresy; and there will be no reproach. The meeting place [of scholars] will become a bordello; the Galilee will be destroyed; the highland will lie desolate; the border people will wander from city to city and none will show them compassion; the wisdom of authors will stink; sin-fearing people will be detested; truth will be missing; young men will humiliate the elderly; the elderly will stand while the young sit; sons will revile their fathers; daughters will strike their mothers, brides will strike their mothers-in-law; and a man's enemies will take over his house. The face of the generation is like the face of a dog! Sons have no shame in front of their fathers; and on whom can one depend? Only upon our father in heaven [Sotah 9:15]."

"The son of David will not arrive until informers are everywhere...Until there are few students left...Until the last coin is gone from the pocket...Until people despair of redemption...as if there is no support or help for Israel [BT Sanhedrin 97a]."

“...ye shall hear of wars and rumors of wars; see that ye be not troubled: for *these things* must needs come to pass; but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against

kingdom; and there shall be famines and earthquakes in divers places. But all these things are the beginning of travail. Then shall they deliver you up unto tribulation, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all the nations for my name's sake. And then shall many stumble, and shall deliver up one another, and shall hate one another. And many false prophets shall arise, and shall lead many astray. And because iniquity shall be multiplied, the love of the many shall wax cold. But he that endureth to the end, the same shall be saved. (Matthew 24:6-13)"

Rapidly conditions just like this are spreading, starting in Israel spreading all over the world. The violence is already beginning in the usually quiet, little, mountaintop mystical city of Sefad, in far North Galilee.. True Believers against the dividing of the Land stand in solidarity with our Jewish brethren opposing the withdrawal from Gush Katif, Gaza and Northern Shomron or any other part of Israel. It is especially repulsive that Israel is poised for a bloodbath. A friend told me never in the history of modern Israel is the nation so close to Civil War.

Demonstrators staged a sit-in at rush hour 5 PM on Wednesday, June 29th, 2005. People blocked traffic, and crossed their legs and crossed their arms and held hands and made an orange chain. And chanted, "Jews don't expel Jews." In the beginning it was mostly teenagers who were blocking the street but later a lot of people joined them. However, traffic moved for anyone who really had a need to get through.

The Israeli policeman came, they were "Yasam," the Riot Police and dragged demonstrators out of the street, beating and kicking them. But the people kept returning. Every time they went back, the police kicked and beat them harder and harder. They're like pit bulls. They got out of the car and they didn't look to the right or the left, they didn't assess the situation. They just attacked. And they didn't care whom.

Then the Druze policeman, that have no tie to the Land, came in using harsher methods literally cracking peoples' heads open, and after their heads was cracked open, they kept beating them all the more. It is reported that one of them pick up a teenaged girl and throw her down on the ground extremely hard breaking bones.

After everyone saw how violent the Riot Police were the streets cleared up real fast. Nobody wanted to get in their way, except one brave young Sefad girl who walked up to the Riot Police and singled one of them out, the most brutal of the four standing there. He had blue eyes and blonde hair, and she said in Hebrew, "I want to give you a blessing. I want to bless you that HaShem (Yahweh) will give you the proper understanding of what is going on in Eretz Israel (Land of Israel). Now you just have to say "Amien". So then all four of the grey uniformed men said, "amien". And she just walked away.

Last week I dealt with the great End time War of the Worlds, but now I want to take you into that wonderful Age of Messiah. I believe we need it!

The Millennium – the Messianic Age

"[In the Messianic Age] there shall be no gloom to her that was in anguish. In the former time [Yahweh] brought into contempt the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali; but in the latter time hath He made it glorious, by the way of the (Dead) sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the nations.

The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwelt in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined. Thou hast multiplied the nation, thou hast increased their joy: they joy before thee according to the joy in harvest, as men rejoice when they divide the spoil.

For the yoke of his burden, and the staff of his shoulder, the rod of his oppressor, thou hast broken as in the day of Midian. For all the armor of the armed man in the tumult, and the garments rolled in blood, shall be for burning, for fuel of fire.

For unto us a child is born (YahShua), unto us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Pele-yoez-El-gibbor-Abi-ad-sar-shalom (Wonderful (pele' {peh'-leh}), Counsellor (ya`ats {yaw-ats'}), Mighty (gibbor {ghib-bore'}) El, Everlasting Father (ad Ab) , Prince of Peace (Sar Shalom)). Of the increase of His government and of peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to establish it, and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of Yahweh of hosts will perform this. (Isaiah 9:1-7)"

Isaiah and the whole of the Prophets of Israel declare that in contrast to this present age of war, gloom, and despair, there is coming an age when peace will reign universally. It will begin with the coming of the Messiah, our promised future king.

The New Covenant

"Behold, days are coming,' declares Yahweh, 'when I will make a New Covenant with the House of Israel and with the house of YaHudah, not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was a husband to them," declares the Sovereign. "But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," declares Yahweh., "I will put My Torah within them, and on their heart I will write it; and I will be their Elohim, and they shall be My people. (Jeremiah 31:31-33)"

"For He has clothed me with garments of salvation, He has wrapped me with a robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with a garland, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels. (Isaiah 61:10)"

After the Battle of Jehosephat, Israel receives blessings. Yahweh shall be King over all the earth during the Millennium. Yahweh will gather the rest of the tribes of Israel that were scattered throughout the nations and bring them back to their land. And they will realize that if they had followed Yahweh, He would bless them. **"Then I passed by you and saw you, and behold, you were at the time for love; so I spread My skirt over you and covered your nakedness. I also swore to you and entered into a covenant with you so that you became Mine," declares the Sovereign Yahweh. "Then I bathed you with water, washed off your blood from you, and anointed you with oil. I also clothed you with embroidered cloth, and put sandals of porpoise skin on your feet; and I wrapped you with fine linen and covered you with silk. And I adorned you with ornaments, put bracelets on your hands, and a necklace around your neck. I also put a ring in your nostril, earrings in your ears, and a beautiful crown on your head. Thus you were adorned with gold and silver, and your dress was of fine linen, silk, and embroidered cloth. You ate fine flour, honey, and oil; so you were exceedingly beautiful and advanced to royalty. Then your fame went forth among the nations on account of your beauty, for it was perfect because of My splendor which I bestowed on you," declares the Sovereign Yahweh. (Ezekiel 16:8-14)"**

"And I will pour on the House of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn. In that day there shall be a great mourning in Jerusalem, like the mourning at Hadad Rimmon in the plain of Megiddo. (Zechariah 12: 10,11)"

Isaiah begins his announcement of the change from this present age to the Messianic Age by informing us there will be no more gloom for those in anguish; in the past Yahweh humbled the northern lands of Zebulun and Naphtali, but in the future he will honor Galilee. Why? It is for two reasons because that is the beginning lines of defense, but mainly because it was the original center of the Netzarim. **"The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwelt in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined. (Isaiah 9:2)"**

Malachi used similar words concerning the Messianic Age when he said that the **"sun of righteousness will rise with healing in his wings"** (4:2). So the people in the north who have suffered so much have the prospect of a wonderful new beginning.

The **"light"** will shine on people who were walking in **"darkness."** Rabbi MattenYahu (Matthew) quotes this very text in conjunction with the beginning of King Messiah YahShua's ministry in Galilee. It was in Galilee that Rebbe YahShua began His ministry, with His teachings and His miracles, He demonstrated that He was indeed this Messiah.

"In [Messiah] was life; and the life was the light of men. And the light shineth in the darkness; and the darkness apprehended it not... There was the true light, *even the light* which lighteth every man, coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through him, and the world knew him not. He came unto his idea, and they that were his idea could not contain him. But as many as received him, to them gave he the right to become children of Yahweh, *even* to them that believe on his name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of Yahweh. (John 1:4,5,9-13)"

It is Messiah's proclamation of the Kingdom through salvation and His demonstration of that Kingdom when He wrestles the World away from the Sitre Ahurah by force that ends the despair, for Believers in Him are not lost in gloom and despair, for they have the realization of the Kingdom in their hearts and they know that what He promised will come to pass at His coming.

"Thus says Yahweh: "Keep justice, and do righteousness, for My salvation is about to come, and My righteousness to be revealed. Blessed is the man who does this, and the son of man who lays hold on it; who keeps from defiling the Sabbath, and keeps his hand from doing any evil.

Do not let the son of the foreigner who has joined himself to Yahweh speak, saying, "Yahweh has utterly separated me from His people"; nor let the eunuch say, "Here I am, a dry tree." For thus says Yahweh: "To the eunuchs who keep My Sabbaths, and choose what pleases Me, and hold fast My covenant, even to them I will give in My House and within My walls a place and a name better than that of sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name that shall not be cut off.

Also the sons of the foreigner who join themselves to Yahweh, to serve Him, and to love the name of Yahweh, to be His servants-- Everyone who keeps from defiling the Sabbath, and holds fast My covenant-- Even them I will bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on My altar; for My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations." The Sovereign Yahweh, who gathers the outcasts of Israel, says, "Yet I will gather to him others besides those who are gathered to him." (Isaiah 56:1-6)"

"...in the latter time hath [Messiah] made [the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali] glorious, by the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the nations. (Isaiah 9:1)" As we emerge out of Jordan, many of us will go to Galilee and settle there bringing our joy with us. "And you (Gentiles) He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.

But Yahweh, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Messiah ...and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Messiah YahShua, that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Messiah YahShua. For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of Yahweh, not of works, lest anyone should boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Messiah YahShua for good works, which Yahweh prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh--who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands-- that at that time you were without Messiah, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without Yahweh in the world. But now in Messiah YahShua you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Messiah. (Ephesians 2:1-13)" We return from Petra as full citizens of the Commonwealth of Israel. Second class to no one. The zeal of Yahweh of hosts will do this.

The Messianic Temple

The Messiah will then rebuild the Temple in Jerusalem.

"I will shake all nations, and [Israel] shall come to the Desire of All Nations (Or *the desire of all nations*), and I will fill this Temple with glory,' says Yahweh of hosts. "The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine,' says Yahweh of hosts. "The glory of this latter Temple shall be greater than the former,' says Yahweh of hosts. "And in this place I will give peace,' says Yahweh of hosts. (Haggai 2:7,8,9)"

"Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads. And I heard a voice from heaven, like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps. They sang as it were a new song before the throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song except the hundred and forty-four thousand who were redeemed from the earth. These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being firstfruits to Yahweh and to the Lamb. And in their mouth was found no deceit, for they are without fault before the throne of Yahweh. (Revelation 14:1-5)"

According to the Sages, Elijah will be High Priest in Messianic days. This is expressly stated in the Targum Jonathan on Ex. 40:10, he will anoint the Messiah with the sacred oil, the composition of which was among the things unknown in the second Temple, but to be restored by Elijah (Tanch. on Ex. 23:20).

“After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our Elohim who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" All the angels stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped Yahweh, saying: "Amien! blessing and glory and wisdom, thanksgiving and honor and power and might, be to our Elohim forever and ever. Amien."

Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?" And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. Therefore they are before the throne of Yahweh, and serve Him day and night in His Temple. And He who sits on the throne will dwell among them. They shall neither hunger anymore nor thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any heat; for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of waters. And Yahweh will wipe away every tear from their eyes." (Revelation 7:9-17)"

On the original coronation stone the Messiah will be anointed. "I am the Elohim of Beth-el, where thou anointedst a pillar, where thou vowedst a vow unto me: now arise, get thee out from this land, and return unto the land of thy nativity. (Genesis 31:13)"

Judgment of the Nations

His throne will be in the Holy of Holies in the Temple from where he will judge the nations. "When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory. All the nations will be gathered before Him, and He will separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats. And He will set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left. Then the King will say to those on His right hand, "Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.'

Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, "King, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink? When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or naked and clothe You? Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?" And the King will answer and say to them, "Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.'

Then He will also say to those on the left hand, "Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels: for I was hungry and you gave Me no food; I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink; I was a stranger and you did not take Me in, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.'

Then they also will answer Him, saying, "King, when did we see You hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to You?" Then He will answer them, saying, "Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.'

And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life. (Matthew 25:31-46)"

“And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment, so Messiah was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation. (Hebrews 9:27,28)"

“Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone. (Revelation 19:20)"

“Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while. (Revelation 20:1-3)"

Rod of Iron

Yahweh will rule over the nations of the world "with a rod of iron".

"But with righteousness He shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked. (Isaiah 11:4)"

The Marriage of the Lamb

" In that day the Branch of Yahweh will be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the earth will be the pride and the adornment of the survivors of Israel. And it will come about that he who is left in Zion and remains in Jerusalem will be called holy ---everyone who is recorded for life in Jerusalem. When the Lord has washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and purged the bloodshed of Jerusalem from her midst, by the spirit of judgment and the spirit of burning, then Yahweh will create over the whole area of Mount Zion and over her assemblies a cloud by day, even smoke, and the brightness of a flaming fire by night; for over all the glory will be a canopy (chuppah). (Isaiah 4:5)"

"... I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude and as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty peals of thunder, saying, "HalleluYah! For Yahweh our Elohim, El Shaddai reigns. Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready." And it was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. And he said to me, "Write, `Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.'" And he said to me, "These are the true words of Yahweh. (Revelation 19:6-9)"

The Messianic Government

His Government will be made up of Rulers which He will select according to His righteous criteria, **"rulers of thousands, and rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens (Exodus 18:21)"** from amongst the overcomers - followers of His who lived according to His Requirements during their lifetime on earth. Citizenship of His Kingdom is open to all humanity, of every race and nation - as long as they comply with His Divine Requirements. The Reward for qualifiers is: Eternal Life in the Presence of the Living Creator.

"...the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our King, and of his Messiah; and he shall reign for ever and ever. (Revelation 11:15)"

"...I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of YahShua, and for the word of Yahweh, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Messiah a thousand years...Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of Yahweh and of Messiah, and shall reign with him a thousand years.(Rev. 20:4)"

"To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.(Revelation 3:21)"

"...he said unto him, Well, thou good servant: because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities. And the second came, saying, Lord, thy pound hath gained five pounds. And he said likewise to him, Be thou also over five cities. (Luke 19:17)"

"But in the last days it shall come to pass, that the mountain of the house of Yahweh shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and people shall flow unto it. And many nations shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of Yahweh, and to the house of the Elohim of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for the law shall go forth of Zion, and the word of Yahweh from Jerusalem. And he shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more...And I will make her that halted a remnant, and her that was cast far off a strong nation: and Yahweh shall reign over them in mount Zion from henceforth, even for ever. (Micah 4:1,2,3,7)"

“He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till he have set judgment in the earth: and the isles shall wait for his law... Yahweh is well pleased for his righteousness' sake; he will magnify the Torah, and make it honourable. (Isaiah 42:4,21)”

“Hearken unto me, my people; and give ear unto me, O my nation: for a law shall proceed from me, and I will make my judgment to rest for a light of the people. (Isa.51:4)”

“...Yahweh shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one Yahweh, and his name one... And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, Yahweh of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles. And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, Yahweh of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain. And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that have no rain; there shall be the plague, wherewith Yahweh will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles. This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.(Zec.14:9,16-19)”

The Final Revolt

At the end of the millennium, the Lucifer is released and heads for Magog to mount a final attack on the Kingdom of Yahweh. All the wicked far and wide head for Russia.

The people of the world have been warned in the Scriptures concerning what is about to happen; they have been told what to expect.

Suddenly, something happens to the billions, or perhaps, hundreds of billions of people. (Those in their spiritual bodies will not be affected.) All of a sudden their minds become full of thoughts of wickedness, rebellion, and hatred. There is a division between those that continue to follow King Messiah YahShua and those that do not. There is a division between Israel and the Anti-Semites. Even though the people of the world have been warned that this would happen, they do not resist the overwhelming power of the Hell scorched Lucifer, Helel ben Shahar; they are consumed with bitterness, hate and evil.

They have been told to beware, for those that do not stand fast with Yahweh shall perish forever. HaSatan goes forth one last time to deceive the nations. There is one final rebellion as the rebels encircle the camp of the saints and the city of Jerusalem.

“Now when the thousand years have expired, haSatan will be released from his prison and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea. They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from Yahweh out of heaven and devoured them. The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever. (Revelation 20:7-10)”

“THOU HAST DEFILED (or desecrated) THY SANCTUARIES BY THE MULTITUDE OF THINE INIQUITIES, BY THE INIQUITY OF THY TRAFFIC; THEREFORE WILL I BRING FORTH (or made) A FIRE FROM THE MIDST OF THEE, IT SHALL DEVOUR (or has consumed) THEE, AND I WILL BRING (or reduced) THEE TO ASHES UPON THE EARTH (or ground) IN THE SIGHT OF ALL THEM THAT BEHOLD THEE (or were watching). ALL THEY THAT KNOW THEE AMONG THE PEOPLE (or all the nations) SHALL BE ASTONISHED (or appalled) AT THEE: THOU SHALT BE A TERROR (or you have come to a horrible end-NIV), AND NEVER SHALT THOU BE ANY MORE. (Ezek 28:18,19)”

After the millennium the second general resurrection will take place and then will come the appointed Day of Judgment! (Revelation 20:7-15)

The Seat of the King

Everyone goes up to the Great White Throne in the Heavens to witness and experience Judgment.

While we are there, a new Heaven and a new Earth is made for the righteous.

"And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. (Revelation 20:11)"

“...the heavens and the earth which are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for fire until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that

with Yahweh one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. Yahweh is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. But the day of Yahweh will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, looking for and hastening the coming of the day of Yahweh, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat? Nevertheless we, according to His promise look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless (2 Peter 3:7-14)."

The Fallen Angels shall be judged, for from the moment the invaders arrived, breathed our air, ate, and drank our food and water, and laid with our women, they were doomed to judgment.

"YAHWEH SPARED NOT THE ANGELS THAT SINNED, BUT CAST THEM DOWN TO HELL, AND DELIVERED THEM INTO CHAINS OF DARKNESS, TO BE RESERVED UNTO JUDGMENT (2 Peter 2:4)."

"THE ANGELS WHICH KEPT NOT THEIR FIRST ESTATE (Pre-Adamic World), BUT LEFT THEIR OWN HABITATION (position), HE HATH RESERVED IN EVERLASTING CHAINS UNDER DARKNESS UNTO THE JUDGMENT OF THE GREAT DAY (Jude 6)."

"IT SHALL COME TO PASS IN THAT DAY, THAT YAHWEH SHALL PUNISH THE HOST OF THE HIGH ONES THAT ARE ON HIGH (or the powers in the heavens above)...AND THEY SHALL BE GATHERED TOGETHER, AS PRISONERS ARE GATHERED IN THE PIT, AND SHALL BE SHUT UP IN THE PRISON, AND AFTER MANY DAYS SHALL THEY BE VISITED (Isaiah 24:21,22)."

"KNOW YE NOT THAT WE SHALL JUDGE ANGELS? HOW MUCH MORE THINGS THAT PERTAIN TO THIS LIFE? (1 Cor 6:3)."

So the Tzaddikim shall be involved in sentencing the Sitra Ahurah (dark forces).

The Second Death

The wicked dead resurrect:

"...many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake...to shame and everlasting contempt. (Daniel 12:2)"

"...the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death. (Revelation 21:8)"

We see the dead stand before the great white throne to be judged by Yahweh.

"And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before Yahweh; and the books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works... And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:12,15)"

Anyone not found in the Lamb's Book of Life receives eternal, conscious punishment.

Matt.8:12 Weeping and wailing are conscious torments (Luke 12:47,48).

Matt. 25:41 Depart into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels.

Matt. 25:46 These go to everlasting punishment, but the righteous into life eternal.

2 Pet. 2:9 The Lord knows how to keep the unrighteous under punishment for the day of judgment.

Jude 7 Sodom and Gomorrah are examples of suffering the punishment of eternal fire.

Jude 13 These people have the blackness of darkness reserved for them forever.

Rev.14:9-11 The smoke of their torment ascends forever; they have no rest day or night.

As we see our friends and love ones who would not accept salvation cast into Hell we grieve.

There will be finger pointing and accusation thrown at us from those facing judgment that will give us regret. It is then that our Sovereign gently wipes away our tears and we remember them no more.

"...I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the Tabernacle of Yahweh is among men, and He shall dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and Yahweh Himself shall be among them, and He shall wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there shall no longer be any death; there shall no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away. (Rev. 21:3)"

“THEN COMETH THE END, WHEN HE SHALL HAVE DELIVERED UP THE KINGDOM TO YAHWEH, EVEN THE FATHER; WHEN HE SHALL HAVE PUT DOWN ALL RULE AND ALL AUTHORITY AND POWER. FOR HE MUST REIGN, TILL HE HATH PUT ALL ENEMIES UNDER HIS FEET. THE LAST ENEMY THAT SHALL BE DESTROYED IS DEATH. FOR HE HATH PUT ALL THINGS UNDER HIS FEET. BUT WHEN HE SAITH ALL THINGS ARE PUT UNDER HIM, IT IS MANIFEST THAT HE IS EXCEPTED, WHICH DID PUT ALL THINGS UNDER HIM. AND WHEN ALL THINGS SHALL BE SUBDUED UNTO HIM, THEN SHALL THE SON ALSO HIMSELF BE SUBJECT UNTO HIM THAT PUT ALL THINGS UNDER HIM, THAT Yahweh (which is the Father) MAY BE ALL IN ALL. (1 Cor 15:24-28)”

“Then Death and Sheol were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. (Revelation 20:14)”

“For since the beginning of the world men have not heard nor perceived by the ear, nor has the eye seen any Elohim besides You, Who acts for the one who waits for Him. (Isaiah 64:4)”

The Olam Habab – the World To Come

"Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which Yahweh has prepared for those who love Him. (1 Corinthians 2:9)"

It is then we go to our New Life on a New Earth under a New Heaven ruled by a New Jerusalem. **“For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; and the former things shall not be remembered or come to mind. But be ye glad and rejoice for ever in that which I create; for, behold, I create Jerusalem a rejoicing, and her people a joy. And I will rejoice in Jerusalem, and joy in my people; and there shall be heard in her no more the voice of weeping and the voice of crying. There shall be no more thence an infant of days, nor an old man that hath not filled his days; for the child shall die a hundred years old, and the sinner being a hundred years old shall be accursed. And they shall build houses, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and eat the fruit of them. They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree shall be the days of my people, and my chosen shall long enjoy the work of their hands. They shall not labor in vain, nor bring forth for calamity; for they are the seed of the blessed of Yahweh, and their offspring with them. And it shall come to pass that, before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear. The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the ox; and dust shall be the serpent's food. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain, saith Yahweh. (Isaiah 65:17-25)”**

“Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. Then I... saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from Yahweh, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband... He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful." And He said to me, "It is done! I am the α and the ω , the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts. He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his Elohim and he shall be My son... "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife." ... a great and high mountain, ... the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from Yahweh, having the glory of Yahweh. Her light was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal. Also she had a great and high wall with twelve gates, and twelve angels at the gates, and names written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: three gates on the east, three gates on the north, three gates on the south, and three gates on the west.

Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. And he who talked with me had a gold reed to measure the city, its gates, and its wall. The city is laid out as a square; its length is as great as its breadth. And he measured the city with the reed: twelve thousand furlongs. Its length, breadth, and height are equal. Then he measured its wall: one hundred and forty-four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of an angel. The construction of its wall was of jasper; and the city was pure gold, like clear glass. The foundations of the wall of the city were adorned with all kinds of precious stones: the first foundation was jasper, the second sapphire, the third chalcedony, the fourth emerald, the fifth sardonyx, the sixth sardius, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoprase, the eleventh jacinth, and the twelfth amethyst. The twelve gates were twelve pearls: each individual gate was of one pearl. And the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass. But I saw no Temple in it, for the Sovereign Yahweh El Shaddai and the Lamb are its Temple. The city had no need of the

sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of Yahweh illuminated it. The Lamb is its light. And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it. Its gates shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there). And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it. But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life. (Revelation 21)”
